To become a Level 1- Accredited Interscholastic Coach a person must complete both Core courses, Fundamentals of Coaching & First Aid For Coaches, and a sport specific course (the sport you coach) OR if a course in your sport is not available you may complete Teaching Sports Skills to achieve Level 1 Certification.
